### How to Get Around the Road Closure

A small section of Highway 1 is closed, however Big Sur remains open and accessible from both north and south.

- Take Hwy 1 → Hwy 68 → Hwy 101 South, then in Paso Robles take Hwy 46 West to reconnect with Hwy 1 near Hearst Castle
- Hwy 1 → Carmel Valley Rd → Arroyo Seco Rd → Hwy 101
